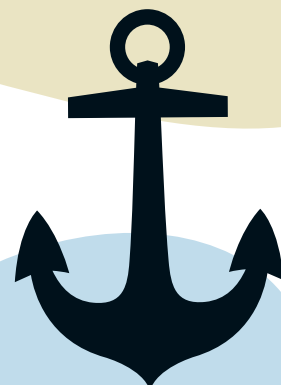


WHAT HOLDS PEOPLE BACK FROM BUYING A BOAT?

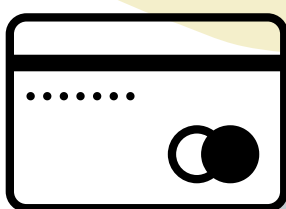


IT'S A COMMITMENT

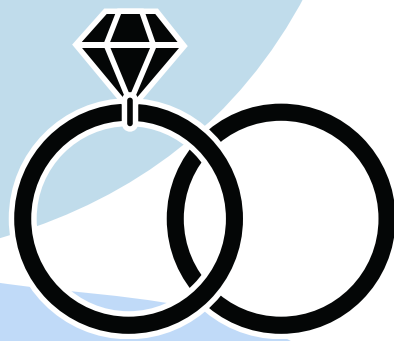
CREDIT CHALLENGES
